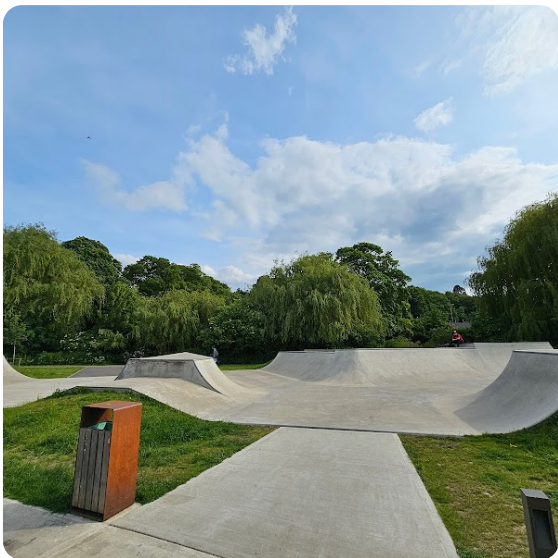


## Activities

There is also a nice river next to the park.



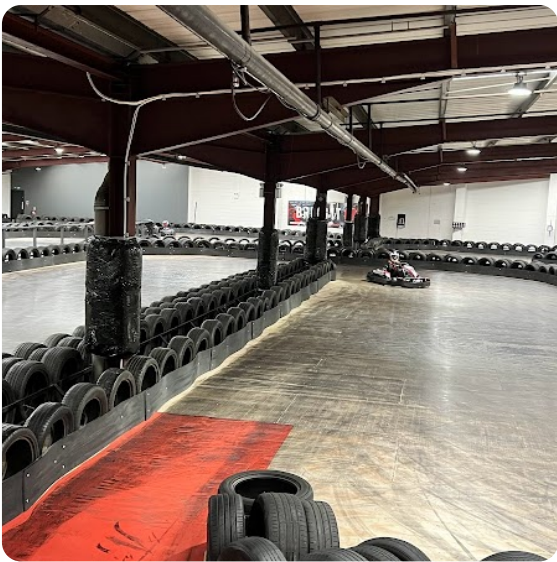

Cassiobury park is 190 acres of open grass and woodland with sports facilities, playground, miniature railway and a nature reserve.

There is a paddling pool which is open between April and September. It also has water jets and fountains. There are toilets and a cafe kiosk on-site.

The old tea pavilion has been refurbished and serves hot and cold food and drinks every day.

There is a miniature railway that has brought joy to families for over 60 years. Tickets are £2.50 per person and children under 2 are free.



## Rock Up Watford

This place is suitable for all ages with walls towering over 8m in height and over 70 challenges to get stuck into. Definitely mountains of fun for the whole family.

Adult spectators are free. Sessions are 90 minutes.
